CONFESSION

*One of the key steps to
enjoying the gospel is
remembering how much
you need it. To help you do
that, think about the
following:*

“Sing to the LORD with thanksgiving; make melody to our God on the lyre! He covers the heavens with clouds; he prepares rain for the earth; he makes grass grow on the hills. He gives to the beasts their food, and to the young ravens that cry. His delight is not in the strength of the horse, nor his pleasure in the legs of a man, but the LORD takes pleasure in those who fear him, in those who hope in his steadfast love” (Psalm 147:7-11).

How Great Is Our God

“A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.” (John 13:44)



“Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.” (1 Corinthians 13:4–7)

Have you been impatient or unkind toward someone lately?

Are you envying another person’s position or ability?

Do you think yourself to be superior to others?

Have you been insisting that your own desires be met?

Have you been having critical thoughts about others?

Have you been reluctant to make sacrifices for the good of others?

Jesus loved others perfectly. And by loving God and others perfectly, Jesus perfectly kept God’s law. But Jesus’ perfect obedience did not just count for himself. God was pleased to credit Jesus’ perfect record of loving obedience to everyone united to him:

“For as by the one man’s disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man’s obedience the many will be made righteous” (Rom 5:19).

And God was pleased to credit our shameful record of lovelessness and lawlessness to Jesus who paid our debt on the cross:

“He made Him who knew no sin to be sin on our behalf, so that we might become the righteousness of God in Him” (2 Cor 5:21).

Let’s demonstrate our faith in these truths by standing and praying the following prayer together:

“O Lord of Grace...All thy lovingkindness is in thy Son, I bring him to thee in the arms of faith, I urge his saving Name as the One who died for me. I plead his blood to pay my debts of wrong...”

PRAYER

We want to humble ourselves before God and confess our sins to Him, trusting in His promise to show mercy to those who come to Him depending on Christ. Each one of you should take a moment to present yourself to God, acknowledge yourself to be a sinner, humbling yourself before God, and believing that He will be gracious to you through Jesus.

GOSPEL PROMISE

God makes big promises to those who come to Him looking for salvation. We honor Him by believing those promises.

Accept his worthiness for my unworthiness, his sinlessness for my transgressions, his purity for my uncleanness, his sincerity for my guile, his truth for my deceits, his meekness for my pride, his constancy for my backslidings, his love for my enmity, his fullness for my emptiness, his faithfulness for my treachery, his obedience for my lawlessness, his glory for my shame, his devotedness for my waywardness, his holy life for my unchaste ways, his righteousness for my dead works, his death for my life.”

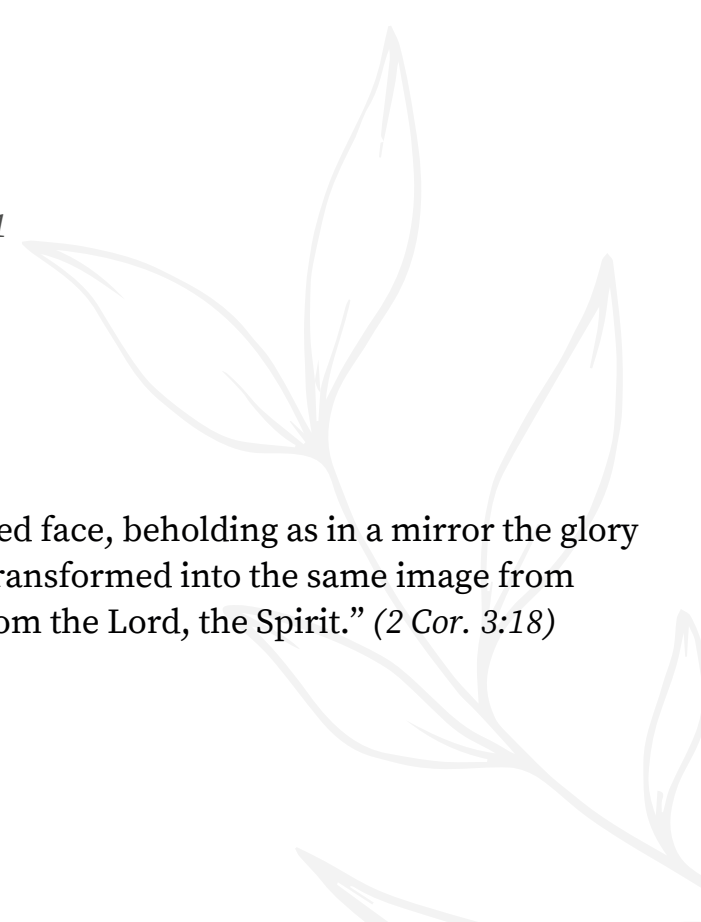

Featured Resource:

“The Bible Storyline”

by Michael Vlach

“Are you confused by the Old Testament? Do you struggle to understand how the New Testament relates to the Old? Does it seem like the two are telling completely different stories?

In *The Bible Storyline*, Michael Vlach helped me see how the Bible is one unified story. He walks through Genesis to Revelation and carefully explains how the Bible is telling the story of “God’s unstoppable plan to defeat evil, restore creation, and establish His kingdom on earth.” If you are struggling to understand the Bible as a unified story, I highly recommend this book. Since it is arranged into 100 short lessons, it could even be a great tool for family devotions.

If you choose to read it, I think you will come away with 1) a cohesive view of the Bible, 2) a better understanding of God’s covenants, 3) a better understanding of how believers in Jesus’ day understood the OT, 4) a better understanding of “the kingdom” in the Bible’s storyline, and 5) a greater love and appreciation for our Lord Jesus—the seed of the woman, the offspring of Abraham, and the Son of David who will defeat evil, restore creation, and establish God’s kingdom on earth.”
