PERSONAL REFLECTION

CONFESSION

One of the key steps to enjoying the gospel is remembering how much you need it. To help you do that, think today about the following commands.

PRAYER

We want to humble ourselves before God, confessing our sins and taking our weaknesses to Him, trusting in His promise to show mercy to those who come to Him depending on Christ. Each one of you should take a moment to present yourself to God, acknowledge yourself to be a sinner and to be needy, believing that He will be gracious to you through Jesus. To help you evaluate whether you are disobeying these commands, consider the following:

GOSPEL PROMISE

God doesn't command us not to worry or fear because He is being hard on us. It is because He loves us. Let's confess together some of the things He says to those who are struggling with fear.

SONGS OF PRAISE

The gospel is good news and should fill our hearts with joy. This is an opportunity for that joy to overflow in song.

SCRIPTURE READING & PASTORAL PRAYER

FRANCIS OREJUDOS

"Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God, believe also in me." John 14:1

"Therefore, I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat, nor about your body, what you will put on." Luke 12:22

"And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell." Matthew 10:28

- Is there something you knew God wanted you to do this week but you didn't do it because you were worried about how it would turn out? Did you do something you shouldn't have done because you were afraid of what other people thought?
- Whose evaluation of you had more power over your life this week, other people or God?
