Important Concepts

- 1. Spiritual danger is real and often overlooked.
 - Jesus teaches that eternal threats are far more significant than temporary physical ones.
- 2. Christians must guard themselves and others.
 - We must live humbly, stay alert, and help others stay on course through loving correction.
- 3. Biblical community is essential for spiritual safety.
 - We need honest, grace-filled relationships where truth is spoken and forgiveness is practiced.
